Translation and distribution of tactical notebooks to Civil Society Organizations in Pakistan

INTRODUCTION

Goals

Pakistan is a country where only half of the population is literate and among this most of the literate population is not capable of understanding the English. Therefore, considering this language constraint a New Tactics in Human Rights Micro-grant project have been planed to translate New Tactics in Human Rights' note book 'making allies: engaging government officials to advance human rights' for practitioners.

The Civil Society Organizations working at the grassroots' level are in the remote areas of Pakistan, therefore are not having access to trainings, information and experience sharing for their own capacity building. Such activities are so important for these CSOs to work more efficiently in their target areas.

Before starting this New Tactics in Human Rights Micro-grant project it was intended that the translated notebooks from New Tactics in Human Rights would surely give these CSOs a direction to interact with government officials in their areas.

New Tactics material

For this project the New Tactics in Human Rights' Note Book '*Making Allies: Engaging Government Officials to Advance Human Rights*' by **Boris Pustyntsev** is translated from English to Urdu to be distributed in Pakistan.

METHDOLOGY

Intended audience

The purpose of this activity is to target the non-government organizations working in the remote areas of Pakistan and don't have access to information available in the cities.

Selection of CSOs

As this project was aimed to target CSOs in the remote areas of Pakistan or the neglected areas and initially after consulting some of the senior activists it was realized that CSOs working outside the provincial capitals always face difficulty in access to information. Therefore, this project has excluded CSOs in the provincial capitals and Federal capital i.e. Lahore, Karachi, Quetta, Peshawar and Islamabad. Furthermore, the city of Rawalpindi has also been excluded because

it is known as twin city of Islamabad and therefore can easily get benefit from any information.

Initially the translated notebook has been sent to 44 CSOs (for details see annexure) in the 24 cities of Pakistan with request to the organizations to forward it among other CSOs and activists.

CONSTRAINT

Most of the CSOs in these areas are facing financial barrier to copy New Tactics in Human Rights notebook and to forward it further, therefore requesting for more copies.

FUTURE STEPS

Due to the great demand for this publication inside Pakistan, it is requested to New Tactics in Human Rights Project of CVT to think about expanding the already done work.

Another step could be load this translated notebooks at www.newtactics.org where people from Urdu speaking regions would access it and take benefit from it. Service of internet has been expanded to the remote areas of Pakistan in the past few years, therefore once it would be loaded on the web a little amount would be required to post letters to all of the organizations in Pakistan, basically to inform them about the availability of this document on the web.
